

Scripture Union's Footsteps of Jesus Lenten Journey begins Wednesday, March 2!






WHO IS JESUS? - INVESTIGATION IN JOHN'S GOSPEL

Scripture Union USA has prepared *Who is Jesus*? for this summer's SuperKids®/VBS outreach, and is excited about this newly updated curriculum based on the Gospel of John. In this 5 or 10-day program, children ages 5-12 will look for clues about Jesus with detectives Shorty Sherlock and Wallaby Watson. It can be used wherever children safely gather – in a virtual setting or in person.

In *Who Is Jesus*? children will use their detective skills and explore the evidence of eye witnesses in John's Gospel to find clues about Jesus. The children will have a Detective Diary to ask their own questions and draw conclusions. *Who Is Jesus*? is filled with Bible story dramas, games, and creative interactive materials, while including Bible memory, Bible Digger discussions, and age-appropriate take-home sheets. Everything is purposed to show who Jesus is and invite children to respond to him in faith.

Leaders and volunteers will be happy to see updated information relevant to everything needed to provide a safe and productive SuperKids[®]. They will love the step-by-step instructions for each day's program, all designed to help children come to faith in Jesus.

This section contains all the Bible Story Dramas needed to introduce the Bible story for the day. Drama is an effective tool in communicating with children. It brings the Scripture to life and helps keep their attention. To prepare the daily dramas, begin by selecting a leader of the drama team, someone with experience if possible. The same people may remain on the drama team the entire mission, or may change, depending on the size and gifts of the team. The drama team should ideally review and rehearse all dramas several days in advance of the beginning of the SuperKids* mission. FOCUS This past July, Scripture Union Romania was ON able to run a children's camp for the 11th year ROMANIA in the Negrești area of the country. National Director, Cristi Maritan said, "This is a place where there are many needs, especially spiritual ones. Every day, we had more than 80 kids showing up and participating in the activities. They spent half a day with us and were full of joy and energy. We were glad to show them love and more importantly, to tell them about God's love for them. Beside the Bible lesson, songs, crafts, and games, every day we offered them lunch, and at the end of the week, we gave them gift bags." Along with the children's camp, the SU team also made food packages for families in need that they distributed in the afternoons. Cristi said, "We talked to these people, we listened to their problems, and we prayed for them." One of the volunteers at the camp, Samy Trif, said, "This summer, I experienced a different kind of serving. I still remember the faces of the kids who would stand on the margins, that needed someone to go there and just show them love and compassion. They just needed to see kindness without any agenda. I'm glad we were able to do that."
